Immerse yourself in this group exhibition on view at the Roxbury Arts Center through April 13. “Forgotten Spaces” explores the personal, metaphorical, and societal structures lost to time, highlighting the gradual decay of once vibrant scenes, reflecting on how both buildings on backroads and the structures we inhabit over the course of our lives can become landmarks for growth and grief.

How do we square away the decay of something only known to us? How does art reanimate spaces that no longer exist on Earth?
